Name of Test : HLA Class I and Class II Tissue Cross Match Antibody Screening Test  
Specimen : Patient serum

Test Result:

The recipient sample showed absence of IgG antibodies to donor specific HLA Class I and HLA Class II antigens.

Test Report:

The sample (7D54333) has been designated as recipient with the donor Saiphuddin Sekh (7D54334). The recipient sample showed absence of IgG antibodies to donor specific HLA class I and HLA class II antigens.

Interpretation:

Presence of HLA antibodies in transplant recipients to the donor cell HLA Class I and Class II antigens will lead to early graft loss or chronic rejection. Class I antigens are expressed on all nucleated cells while Class II antigens are expressed on antigen presenting cells.

Test Indications:

HLA IgG antibody detection is indicated for determining survival of transplant allografts or transfused platelets in sensitized individuals. HLA antibodies can be acquired through allo-immunization as a result of pregnancy, transfusion of blood products, or previous transplants.

Test Specification:

At Molecular Medicine, RLS, HLA class I and class II crossmatch is done using MicroAMS kit, which is based on qualitative solid phase enzyme linked immunosorbant assay (ELISA) for the detection of IgG antibodies to donor specific HLA class I and class II antigens in recipient serum. The test indicates a sensitivity and specificity of 92.7% to 100% (as reported by Manufacturers).

Clinical Significance:

Antibodies to HLA glycoprotein contraindicate successful transplantation. Post transplant monitoring of these antibodies is important in assessing potential graft-survival.

Limitations of the Assay:

Erroneous results can occur from bacterial contamination of test materials, presence of immune complexes or immunoglobulin aggregates. Some low titre, low avidity antibodies may not be detected in the assay. The assay detects IgG antibodies only.
