Surgery/Procedure

BD Glenn procedure with ligation and division of bilateral BT shunt + LPA plasty with pericardial patch from PA bifurcation to left hilum + Atrial septectomy.

Present Illness

History of Present Illness Baby NAYRA DHARMI, 5 years old female is a follow up case of CHD with DORV with non routable VSD with severe PS with S/P bilateral BT shunts admitted in Indraprastha Apollo Hospital, Sarita Vihar, New Delhi for further evaluation and management.

Clinical Examination

Weight 13.7 kg

On Examination Heart Rate: 104/min, Respiratory Rate: 20/min, Temp 98.6°F, Blood pressure 100/60, SPO2 74% with room air
Cyanosis +, clubbing +
Cardiovascular system: S1, S2 (+), CNS-conscious, oriented
Per abdomen: Soft, bowel sounds (+)
Respiratory system: Air entry + equal

Course In The Hospital & Discussion

Patient admitted at Indraprastha Apollo Hospital on 16/05/2024. Relevant investigations were sent and report incorporated. Pre-op Echo revealed DORV with non routable VSD with severe PS with S/P bilateral BT Shunt. Patient operated on 17/05/2024 and BD Glenn procedure with ligation and division of bilateral BT shunts + LPA plasty with pericardial patch from PA bifurcation to left hilum + atrial septectomy was done. Patient shifted out of OT with IPPV, inotropic support, IV fluids, IV antibiotics, IV Sedation along with other supportive treatment. Post operative Echo done which revealed Glenn function patent, no obstruction, normal ventricular function, no pericardial / pleural effusion. Patient managed accordingly as per protocol with intensive monitoring and showed improvement gradually hence inotropes tapered down, weaning started and extubation done on post op day 1. Feed introduced, tolerated well hence optimized gradually to full feed along with IV fluid adjustment. Chest X ray done which revealed diffuse infiltrates. In view of Tachycardia, Ivabradin was given as and when required. ECG and A wire study showed normal sinus rhythm. Patient suffered gastroenteritis which was managed conservatively. Vitals before discharge HR : 141/min, RR: 26/min, BP: 108/53 (75), Spo2: 80% with room air. Echo before discharge showed well functioning right BDG, no flow obstruction or reversal, good flow in RPA, LPA flow could be seen though reduced, good ventricular contractility, mild B/L AVVR, no pleural/pericardial effusion. At present child is hemodynamically stable with ongoing treatment, accepting and tolerating oral feed well, passing urine and stool adequately, active and playful hence being discharged with follow up advice and precautions. Danger signs explained in detail. Parental counselling done.

ADVICE ON DISCHARGE

Diet As advised

Physical Activity

- Following activity to be restricted for 3 months to allow breastbone (sternum) to completely heal: Avoid rough play or activities likely to injure the chest wall: bicycling, climbing, rollerblading, skateboarding or contact sports for 6 months.
- Not to lift objects weighing more than 3- 5 kg (backpacks, younger siblings, pets, etc.) for 3 months.
- To keep arm immobilized for 24hrs after pacemaker placement.
- Avoid lifting the arm above the head. Lift the baby by holding under the arms for 4 weeks.

Discharge
Medication

Tab Lanzol JR (15) 1 tab per orally once daily
Europed drop 0.5 ml per orally twice daily
Tab Aldactone (25 mg) 1/3rd Tab per orally once daily
Syp Zinconia 5 ml per orally once daily
Tab Ciplar 5 mg per orally once daily
Syp Taxim O Forte (100mg/5 ml) 3.5 ml twice daily x 4 more days
Tab Ecospirin 75 mg per orally once daily (after meals)- hold for 2 days and restart again after follow-up

Other advice

- Bacterial endocarditis prophylaxis as advised.
- Fetal echo of mother to be done at 18 weeks during the next pregnancy.
- Live vaccination after 6 weeks.

Nurse in sitting position
keep child calm

Follow up

Follow up with surgeon Dr. Muthu Jothi after 2 days, with prior appointment.
